### **ETERNITY Systems presentation**

MT Systems **started in 1994** with the cleaning of reusable food containers in a garage in Perpignan. In 1995 the company **went international** with the opening of Spain, and from **2010 onwards**, the activity was extended to Europe and North America. For a quarter of a century, the company has remained true to its ambition: to offer technological solutions and increasingly rigorous washing processes adapted to the development of sustainable packaging.

In 2021, ETERNITY Systems will become the MT Systems Group brand. Noting the development of a circular economy at the heart of which lies the reuse of primary, secondary and tertiary containers and packaging, it was decided to make the Group's industrial know-how in transport, washing, storage and automation for all industries available to industrialize this new economy.



# Examples of processes implemented by ETERNITY Systems engineers to optimise water and energy flows

#### Efficient water recycling

Our most recent sites have an internal water treatment plant which allows the reuse of industrial quality water. IL is reused 300 times wich reduces the water demand by up to 70%.




#### **Heat recovery**

Some of our wash centres are equipped with a CHP (Combines Heat Power) system: they produce electricity that is sold to the grid, and recover the heat from the production to heat the wash water. By replacing our traditional dryers with centrifuges, we have reduced our electricity and gas consumption by over 40%.





# Strict hygiene procedures confirmed by a certification process









- Strict hygiene requirements apply to the food and cosmetics industry.
- ETERNITY Systems guarantees the quality of the products and processes used.
- Each of our sites applies HACCP and is ISO45001 and ISO9001 certified.

In order to guarantee food **safety**, **microbiological tests** are carried out

- Daily in our own laboratories at every shift change;
- In addition, we regularly have our test results confirmed by independent auditing institutes.






