The Dutch EPR legislation

- Started in July 2023 | First reporting deadline: August 2024
- Targets to be met in 2025:
 - 50% reuse and recycling, of which;
 - at least 20% reuse
 - At least 10% reuse in the Netherlands
 - At least 25% of the recycling needs to be fibre-to-fibre
- Targets to be met in 2030:
 - 75% reuse and recycling, of which;
 - at least 25% reuse
 - At least 15% reuse in the Netherlands
 - At least 33% of the recycling needs to be fibre-to-fibre

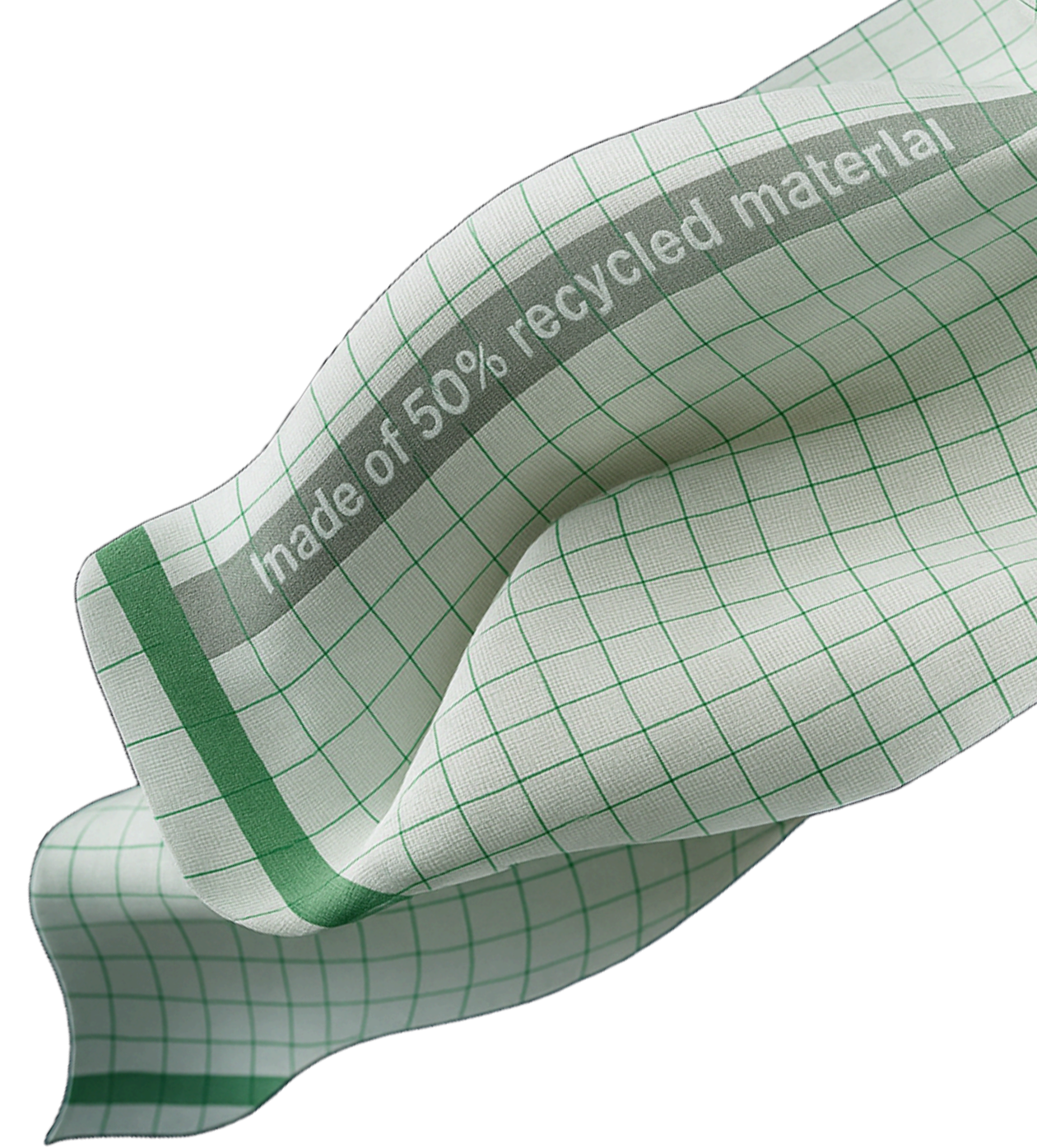
Compliance → Currently 3 PROs in the Netherlands

- Producers legally individually responsible
- PRO can fulfill compliance in a collective manner
- PRO can set fee structure



What makes CCT different?

- Started from environmental NGO Fair Resource Foundation
- Based on years of EPR research for a.o. packaging, tires, electronics
 - Monopolies don't work for circularity
- Sole focus on making impact, no other interest
- Setting & scaling up systems *together* with stakeholders
 - Bottom-up approach
- CCT as a blueprint for other European countries
